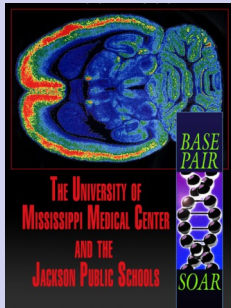

Annual Progress Report Information Needed ASAP

Composition of the Annual Progress Report to the Howard Hughes Medical Institute is underway. All Lead Teachers for Base Pair, SOAR and Rural Biomedical Initiative programs are requested to bring the following information to the Wednesday, September 5 Group of Five meeting—or send it to Dr. Rockhold by e-mail by Friday, September 7. Critical items needed include:

- Number of students in the 2006-2007 classes, identifying gender, race and grade level for each student.
- Any grants submitted during 2006-2007, including title, organization from which the funding was solicited, and amount of funds awarded.
- Any awards obtained by students during 2006-2007, by students or teachers.
- All presentations made by students and teachers, including the name of the event at which the presentation was given. This includes Science Fair presentations.
- Teachers should indicate the grade levels taught by each teacher during 2006-2007.
- A request for additional information was e-mailed to you last week by Ms. Howell.

Lead Teachers—If you have not already done so, please submit your “red book” information to Gail Howell immediately.

For 2007-2008, please make arrangements to submit a photograph of your class for the 2007-2008 year, identifying each student by name. These will be used for the 2007-2008 Progress Report.

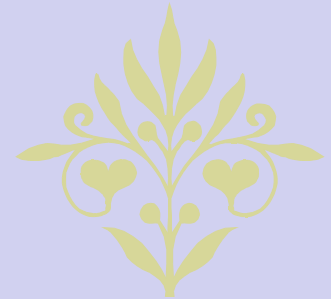
The deadline for the report submission to the Howard Hughes Medical Institute is September 14, 2007, but due to other obligations, the report will need to be completed prior to September 12.
